


CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- Allow to dry thoroughly before storing. Do not store when wet.


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS











6 Peg down the Gazebo at the base of each corner. Use the guy ropes and pegs to secure firmly.



OR fill base flaps with rocks or sand to secure Gazebo.

HELPFUL TAKE-DOWN TIPS:

- Remove door frame pole set first 1.
- 2. Roll down and zip up the door panel
- 3. Pull down roof top (watch your head!)
- 4. Push in wall panels one at a time
- Store in carry bag
